

Committee Statement

June 2015

The current small number of committee members is causing serious problems to the running of the League. There are a number of areas where a lack of members is an issue. To highlight a couple of problems we experience:

Firstly, we are unable to establish a quorum at the majority of committee meetings so no decisions can be made which reduces the relevance of the minutes of the meeting. Secondly, there is limited support for the Match Secretary, a job we all know is difficult and time consuming, and support is needed for such things as organising Semi and Finals nights, venues, refreshments and referees. Many tasks are falling on the same few members.

It is of paramount importance that the Committee comprises of a member from each Club in the League to enable it to continue. At present, apart from serving officers, there is no representation from the following Clubs:

The issue is serious so **UNLESS** increased support is forthcoming it is quite possible that the League will be unable to continue to operate, something I am sure none of us want to see happen.
