

Liverpool Snooker League AGM

The Annual General Meeting for the Liverpool Snooker League was held on Monday 19th June at Brnesc. The main points to come out of the meeting were as follows,

- The minutes of the last AGM were agreed and signed.
- The secretary issued his report which can be viewed on the documents tab.
- The treasurer's report showed a profit of £310.75 and that we are in a reasonable position financially.
- Election of officers, it was agreed that all the management team would remain unchanged.
- Special expenses, It was agreed that these would remain unchanged after a reduction the previous year.
- Notices of motions, The outcome of the 5 motions received within the stipulated period were,
 1. The Noel Beeby format to be changed to the winners being the team who win 4 frames, (Passed by majority) to be reviewed after next season.
 2. Deciding of venues for semi-finals and finals in the individual competitions, (Passed by majority)
 3. All frames to be played to a finish in all competitions except the Noel Beeby due to the format changing, (Pass unanimous)
 4. Unscrewing of or putting away of your cue whilst opposing player is in play to be treated as conceding of the game, (Pass unanimous)
 5. Clubs/individuals are responsible to return trophies in good condition or face costs of repair/replacement, (Pass unanimous)

 - Team secretaries to issue list of players for the new season to league secretary (KR) by the end of July.
 - City Rileys to enter a team for the new season.
